The state of Utah is offering free rapid antigen testing on Tuesdays and Thursdays in March. Testing will be a *drive-through* style where testers may remain in the car, and it takes just a few minutes.

Anyone older than age five can get tested at these free testing clinics, even if they do not have symptoms of COVID-19. Anyone who has any symptoms, even mild ones, should come and get tested. Testing is also available if you have recently been exposed to the virus.

Testing is provided by the Utah Department of Health and the Utah National Guard. It is a valuable opportunity to identify people in our area who may not have symptoms but have COVID-19.
