Cosmetology Training Plan

•Training Schedule Cosmo

First 300 hours	(3 hour days in class 5 days weekly)
Next 600 hours	(6 hour days in class & clinical)
Last 700 hours	(15 - 40 hour weeks in clinical)

•Fast Track Option

First 900 hours	(6 hour days in class & clinical 5 days weekly)
Last 700 hours	(15 – 40 hour weeks in clinical)

You will stay in the same time lane for classes. Clinical/salon lab time can vary, but you will keep a consistent weekly schedule.

The minimum 1600 hour completion is up to you, your schedule and your commitment to passing the required skills.

*** Students must attend every day. A/B schedules will not work.**

Hair Designer Training Plan

•Training Schedule Hair Designer

First 300 hours (3 hour days in class 5 days weekly)
Last 900 hours (15 - 40 hour weeks in clinical)

•Fast Track Option

First 300 hours (6 hour days in class 5 days weekly)
Last 900 hours (15 – 40 hours weeks in clinical)

You will stay in the same time lane for classes. Clinical/salon lab time can vary, but you will keep a consistent schedule.

The minimum 1200 hour completion is up to you, your schedule and your commitment to passing the required skills.

*** Students must attend every day. A/B schedules will not work.**

Esthetician Training Plan

•Training Schedule Basic Esthetician

First 270 hours (3 hour days in class 5 days weekly)

Last 330 hours (15 - 40 hour weeks in clinical)

You will stay in the same time lane for classes. Clinical/salon lab time can vary, but you will keep a consistent schedule.

The minimum 600 hour completion is up to you, your schedule and your commitment to passing the required skills.

***Basic Estheticians may go to Master Esthetics 600 more hours (1200 total hours).**

*** Students must attend every day. A/B schedules will not work.**

Nail Tech Training Plan

•Training Schedule Nail Tech

First 210 hours	(3 hour days in class 5 days weekly)
Last 100 hours	(15 - 40 hour weeks in clinical)

You will stay in the same time lane for classes. Clinical/salon lab time can vary, but you will keep a consistent schedule.

The minimum 300 hour completion is up to you, your schedule and your commitment to passing the required skills.

*** Students must attend every day. A/B schedules will not work.**

College Requirements

- 85% attendance
- 80% average test scores
- 100% skills

Attendance **cannot** be waived for high school activities.

Time and coursework must be **made-up outside of class time** if absent.

If you don't meet the college requirements for a course, you will **retake** the course to complete your program.

*You could earn a **C for high school** and need to **retake the college course** until you achieve **B-** or greater to complete your program.

1 college class grade = **4 high school class grades**, in 8 period high school.

Who Pays for What

Tuition is waived while you are in high school, including the class that is on your college schedule at the time of your high school graduation.

Lab fees, supplies and kits are paid by student.

There will be model fees when you are in class and potentially other fees in clinicals. You will need to **buy extra manikins or supplies** as you progress through the program.

All **kits should last** beyond the Davis Tech training. Our goal is to create professionals that are job ready.

Complete college enrollment, get Davis Tech student ID before you submit your application. *However, you do not need to pay the \$40 fee until **after** you have been accepted by the program.* (Contact information for Student Services and deadlines for enrollment will be sent to you after you have been accepted into the program)
 1. Decide program (Hair Design, Cosmetology, Esthetics) and submit the application delivered to Davis Tech before 4 p.m. **February 25, 2022.**

Helpful Hints & Bonus Points

- Keep a **personal copy** of documents
- Hard copies in a **9"X12" envelope**
Electric copies are accepted, not preferred
- **20 extra points** for paper copies that follow instructions
- **10 extra points** for submissions delivered to Davis Tech **BEFORE** February 25, 2022
- **Human Anatomy or Physiology** can take the place of English grades
- **Extra points** with English + Human Anatomy or Physiology

Credits Apply to a Degree

You can receive up to **30 credits** from your Davis Tech certificate (if program is over 900 hours) with some universities for an **Associates of Applied Science** upon Davis Tech graduation!

Start the Process

- Meet with your high school CTE Coordinator to verify eligibility (your grades and high school graduation is on track which would allow you to enroll at Davis Tech).
- Follow the application process from Davis Tech web site or Sheresa's email. All documents are found on the program page, www.davistech.edu/cosmetology (substitute other programs as needed - Hair Designer or Esthetics), lower right side under "High School Students" heading.
- **BEFORE** you submit your application, make sure you get your Davis Tech Student ID #. Register at DavisTech.edu> Next Steps> Apply Now

Make YOUR Decision

High School graduation comes first!

- Make sure you are current with grades and attendance.
- Make a conscious decision regarding activities beyond the classroom – what are your interests, vacation plans, personal responsibilities, and your family expectations?
- **Realize, this will be your only extra curricular activity.**
- Team sports, Drama, Cheerleading, Band, etc. becomes too much to balance and meet attendance requirements for either the team/group and Davis Tech. (You are only allowed 10 absences for a full year; this includes sick days and we do not accept excused absences for high school events.)
- **Remember – High School only happens once, and we want you to have a great experience! We will be here after high school graduation if you have a busy senior schedule and you don't want to give up an activity/sport/event, etc.**
