

## Davis Technical College Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid

Financial Aid at Davis Technical College can include federal Pell grants, scholarships, and tuition waivers. We advise students to complete the following process to access all the funding that they may be eligible to receive. Financial aid staff members are available to help students through this process.

## Apply for a Davis Tech program.

- Explore program options at <a href="https://www.davistech.edu/programs">https://www.davistech.edu/programs</a>.
- You will be assigned a Davis Tech student id number, if you do not already have one.

## Apply by filling out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <a href="https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa">https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa</a>.

- You will need to create your studentaid.gov account (FSA ID) to log in.
  - o If you have an account but cannot remember log in, please use the forgot password system.
  - The Department of Education will verify your identity with the Social Security Administration which usually takes 3 days.
- Log back into your studentaid.gov account and fill out the FAFSA application
  - o 2025/2026 FAFSA application is for the 7/1/25 6/30/26 school year
    - 2026/2027 FAFSA application will open in October for the 7/1/26 to 6/30/27 year.
  - o Please list Davis Tech (federal school code 015195) as a school of interest.
  - Once a contributor gives consent, the IRS will transfer tax information automatically.
    - If consent is not given by any contributor, then not eligible for any federal aid.
  - o Dependent students will send an invite to parent contributor. You will need to know their name, date of birth, social security number, and email address (must match their FSA ID).
    - Parent contributor(s) will get an email to log in and enter their information for the FAFSA application.
- If you have Pell eligibility, you will receive further instructions from Davis Tech by email in about 7 days.
  - Davis Tech does not participate in the federal loan program.
- If you do not have Pell grant eligibility or if you have applied to a program that is not Pell eligible, then a scholarship application will be created on your behalf.
  - Scholarship applications will be reviewed once you are accepted to the program. You will receive an email notifying you of the award approximately 2 to 3 weeks after you are accepted to the program.
    - During peak processing time (April June) we must prioritize awarding based on cohort start dates and processing can take up to 5 weeks.
  - If you are not eligible to apply for FAFSA (undocumented or DACA) then you can email financialaid@davistech.edu for a link to a scholarship application.
    - You will be required to upload household income verification, such as taxes.
