Eligibility and Admissions Requirements

High School student must submit transcripts. Cumulative GPA of 2.0 and successful completion of **Math 2** (B or higher) and **English 2** (B or higher) are required to waive testing for high school students. Some programs have higher GPA requirements. Grades for Math and English are not averaged.

Students must have the minimum require grade for two quarters or one semester in the same school year. ACT scores may waive some Math and Reading requirements based on each program. Advanced Automotive	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade. Completed Automotive Tech program first. Driver's License required.
Advanced E.M.T.	18 or older and completed EMT. Has Additional requirements.
Architectural And Engineering Design	Must be 16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade
Automation And Robotics	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade
Automotive	16 years or older on or before the first day class. 11th or 12th grade. Driver's License required.
Business Services	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade
CNC Machining	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade
Composite	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade
Construction	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade
Cosmetology	Must apply January or February of junior year to start program senior year. 16 years or older of age AND be in 12th grade to start program.
Culinary Arts	16 years or older of age AND be in 11th or 12th grade
Cybersecurity	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade. Must have completed Information Technology first.
Dental Assisting	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade
Diesel Automotive	16 years or older on or before the first day class. 11th or 12th grade. Driver's License required.
Electrical Apprenticeship	Encourage only seniors for this program. Starting as a junior can have complications with required future apprenticeship hours.
E.M.T.	Be close to 18 years old. Has additional requirements.
Esthetician	Must apply January or February of junior year to start program senior year. 16 years or older of age AND be in 12th grade to start program.
Firefighter	Must be 18 or older. Has additional requirements.
Hair Designer	Must apply January or February of junior year to start program senior year. 16 years or older of age AND be in 12th grade to start program.
Heating And Air Conditioning	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade
Information Technology	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade
Master Esthetician	Admissions requirement: Completion of Davis Tech Esthetician, or Cosmetology License or Esthetician License. Has other additional program requirements.
Medical Assistant	Students must be at least 17 years old to enroll into the Medical Assistant program, however, they must be 18 years old to begin their clinical rotations which take place at the end of the program.
Medical Coding and Billing	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade
Nail Technician	16 years or older AND be in 11th or 12th grade
Nursing Assistant	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade
Pharmacy Technician	Close to 18 years old. Has Additional requirements.
Phlebotomy	18 years or older. Has Additional requirements.
Plumbing	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade
Practical Nurse	Must be 18 years or older and requires college prerequisites & additional requirements.
Software Development	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade. Completed Information Technology program first.
Surgical Technology	High school students must be in second semester of senior year and must be 18 years or older by March 1st. Has Additional program requirements.
Web And Graphic Design	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade
Welding	16 years or older on or before the first day class be in 11th or 12th grade
