Electrical Apprenticeship student Tytan Smith developed a passion for electrical work during a summer job in high school. So, in his senior year, he enrolled at Davis Tech to become an electrician. He competed in SkillsUSA competitions as a student, finishing with multiple gold medals. He also competed in the IDEAL National Championship with over thirty-five thousand other electricians. Amazingly, he placed in the top 30.
