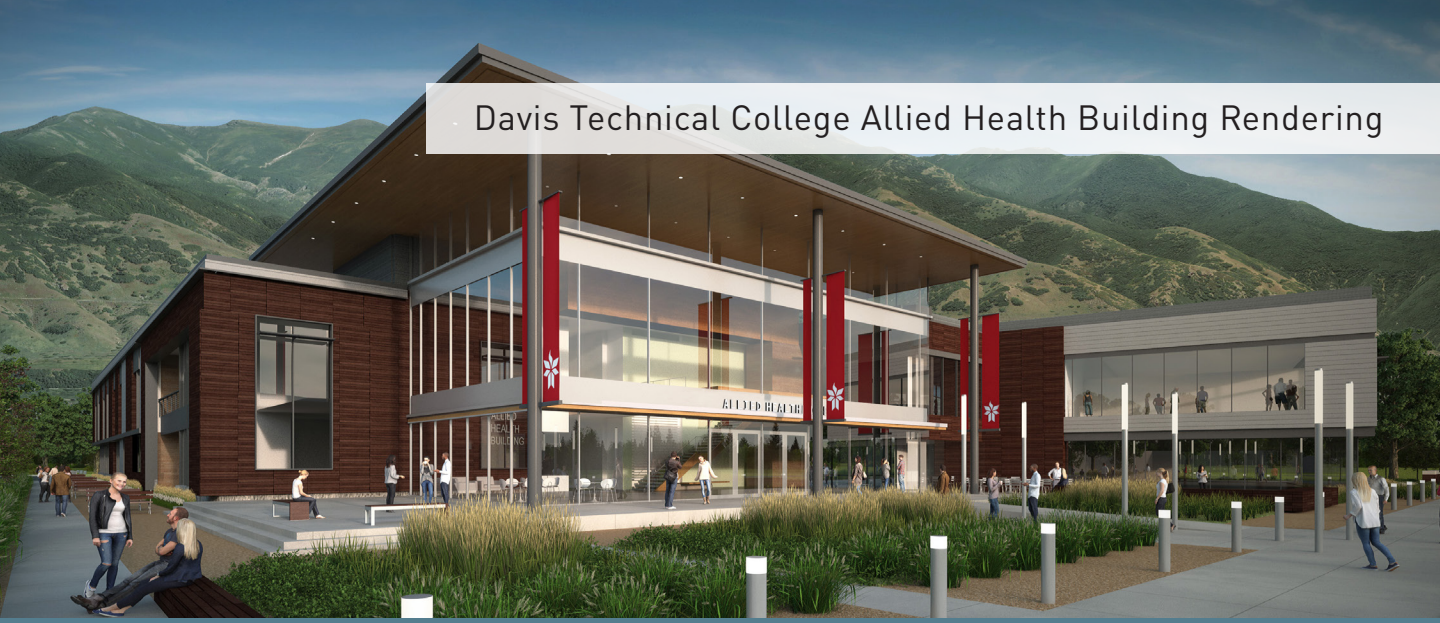
# DONOR SPOTLIGHT
